

Assured Land-Based Contractor (CIPC Application) Scheme

AIMS

The NAAC Assured Land-Based Contractor (CIPC Application) Scheme aims to promote professionalism amongst CIPC applicators and will encourage high levels of working practices within the industry. It will establish a framework of good and safe working practices, to be verified by NSF International assessors, ensuring that the product is only applied by professional, qualified operators under strictly controlled conditions.

SCHEME STRUCTURE

The NAAC scheme is designed to help those involved in CIPC application put in place an operation which is tightly and safely controlled, ensuring:

- personnel are suitably skilled and qualified;
- machinery is regularly and appropriately calibrated and tested;
- CIPC storage and transport meets legal requirements;
- emergency procedures are in place;
- full traceability through record keeping;
- hazards are identified and controlled.

Scheme members must successfully pass a generic and CIPC specific module. The scheme is open to NAAC members and non-members.
