Representing your Interests...

The NAAC has a place on numerous Government and industry stakeholder groups across the UK, ensuring that contractors are recognised in policy and funding developments. The NAAC has three key policy asks for contractors:



NAAC Ask: Policy and decision makers must consider the role of contractors. This cannot be underestimated, and it is essential that our farmers 'without' land are recognised alongside their fellow farmers 'with' land in policy and funding opportunities.

NAAC Ask: Contractors and farmers should be allowed/trusted to use their skill and professionalism to judge when inputs can be applied. This should not be managed by calendar dates set in Government legislation and guidance, which take no account of changing climate.

NAAC Ask: Contractors must remain at the forefront of Government funding and policy to bring forward new technology in agriculture.

The NAAC is also active in specific technical areas across the UK including:

Safety: Farm Safety Partnership Board in England and Wales/ HSE Agricultural Advisory Board - helping our sector stay safe

Careers: Promoting careers in the contracting sector. Managing and promoting NAAC labour list and advertising on behalf of members via the NAAC Jobs Board. Supporting agricultural Universities and Colleges with contracting case studies and student career talks

Agricultural Operations: Trailer weights/Red diesel/Load Handling on trailers/Defra Agricultural Productivity Group

Crop Spraying/Precision Agriculture: NAAC provides members with CPD points and training/NAAC is represented on Voluntary Initiative Board/ BASIS Board/ NRoSO Advisory Board / National Sprayer Test Scheme (NSTS) Board/Defra Drone Stakeholder Group

Land Drainage: Leading a Soil and Land Drainage Advisory Group/Providing annual industry drainage training/supporting research/lobbying Government for drainage funding for farmers
